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ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 has emphasized on the overall transformation of school education especially focusing on holistic development of learners at every stage of schooling. It specifically emphasises on reforming school curricula and pedagogy so that learning can be holistic, integrated, enjoyable and engaging. In order to facilitate such reformations, the policy has proposed transforming assessment to make it a continuous process of more formative, more competency-based, to promote learning and holistic development. Such assessment practices focus on higher-order skills such as analysis and critical thinking. Several efforts in this direction have already been initiated by the Ministry of Education, Government of India as well as state governments including the National Assessment Centre, PARAKH (Performance Assessment, Review, and Analysis of Knowledge for Holistic Development), as a standard-setting body under the Ministry of Education, since February 2023.

Against this background, the deliberations involving practitioners and experts from different states of the country shall be useful in reflecting on opportunities and priorities for effective implementation of the recommendations of NEP 2020 for enhancing the quality of practices of holistic assessment at the school level. This National Conference is intended to bring practitioner teachers, experts, and state and central boards on a common platform through a medium of research based deliberations, discussion and dialogues on effective implementation of NEP 2020 with regard to transformation in assessment at the school level. The National Conference will outline the success stories, evidence-based best practices, context-specific challenges and priorities for implementation of the vision of NEP towards transforming assessment for the holistic development of students at the school level.

GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

The full paper should be within 2500 to 3000 words excluding references and abstract, typed in MS Word with Times New Roman 12 font size, 1.5 line spacing and alignment left. The cover page should reflect the title of the paper, name of the author(s), designation, institutional affiliation and address, e-mail ID and contact number of the corresponding author. The theme under which they are submitting and the mode of presentation (oral or poster) also need to be specified on the cover page.

The abstract should be 250-300 words, which reflects objectives, method, major findings, results and major implications.

The full original paper along with the abstract should be organized in the following format.

Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Aims/objectives, Hypotheses (if any), Method, Results and Discussion, Conclusion and Implications and Acknowledgement (if any).

* Case studies, best practices and success stories can also be submitted in the form of articles.

APA 7th edition, 2020 format is to be followed in References.

Plagiarism Alert: The paper should be free of plagiarism. A self-declaration regarding the originality of the paper is to be attached.
