ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 proposes the revision and revamping of all aspects of the education structure, including its regulation and governance, to create a new system that is aligned with the aspirational goals of 21st century education, including SDG 4 with focus on India's traditions and value systems. This will have implications for teacher education. The NEP 2020 recommendations like 4-year integrated B.Ed. by 2030, as the minimal degree qualification for school teachers draw special attention for policy implementation.
