- The staff council meeting was held on 6thOctober, 2022 in the staff common room of the Institute under the chairmanship of Esteemed Principal Prof P.C.

- Principal Prof P.C. Agarwal extended his warm welcome to all the learned faculty members present in the house.
 - He informed about the completion of admission of B. Sc. B.Ed., B. A. B. Ed. programmes.
 - Furthermore, he informed the house about the Admission programmes of B. Ed. and M. Ed. which is scheduled to be held during 10th - 12th October, 2022.
 - He requested all the Head of the Departments to ensure that all the classes are to be engaged as per the time table.
 - \circ He informed that KALA UTSAV is to be held during 3^{rd} to 7^{th} January, 2023 in which he requested the faculties to make it successful with full cooperation.
 - He emphasized that Staff council meeting will be held regularly.

The Staff Council meeting was held on 6th July at 5.10 PM in the staff common room of the institute under the chairmanship of Prof P.C Agarwal, Principal. At the outset Prof. S.K Dash Secretary, Staff Council, welcomed the principal and the faculty members to the meeting. Principal said that as today is the first Thursday and the institute conducts the staff council meeting on first Thursday of every month. Prof Agarwal appreciated to all faculty members for putting the effort for 52 number of Clarification of NAAC DVV in timely manner. The institute has submitted NAAC DVV on 1st July 2023. Prof. Agarwal informed that the peer assessment of NAAC is due for which all the faculty members should be very careful. He highlighted that the NAAC peer team may visit to each and every department of Institute, DM School, Hostels, Guest Houses, canteen, campus etc. and for observation of school internship. All members have to be vigilant during their visit as they may go to the campus for looking at the cleanliness, polythene free campus, green initiative, bio-gas plant, solar panel, sewerage treatment plant etc. For better presentation the mock peer team visit is required, which will arrange before their visit. He informed that our use of Hindi for official purpose in only 14%, which needs to be increased as per the rule. He informed that the interview for contractual are going to be over. The interview for JPF and Project staff for studio will be held on 13th July 2023.

He also informed to the house that the new session for the odd semester has started from 4th July 2023, bio-metric attendance facility for students has been installed in different locations. Still the teacher will take attendance as per earlier practice. The pre-conference of school internship for BEd, BSc, BEd and BA, BEd is going on and internship will start from 12th for BEd and 16th for Integrated course. It is requested to all faculty members to visit two times different JNVs for internship supervision. He also requested to all faculty members to take all classes regularly. He informed that workshop in going on for the development books for Kui and Desia tribal languages. The institute is going to sign an MOU with Andaman & Nicobar Islands. We are trying to publish the result of final year students as all marks are submitted to the University. The NIL, Konark has requested for resource persons on e-content development, Dr. Dhanya and other members are deputed for the purpose to support them. The CEE 2023 has been completed on 2nd July 2023. Two PAC programmes such as DCGC and Resource

centre has not been approved by the PAC. Prof. I.P. Gowramma has raised concern on low attendance of integrated course students in pre-conference of internship. Prof. Senapati added that we should be very strict on this internship matter and also Prof. B.N Panda suggested we should fix up the arrival date of students and the date of commencement of internship Prof. Agarwal has requested to the internship coordinators, Heads of Dept. and Dean to look the matter and take appropriate decision. For DPSE programme 14 seats and for Two Year BEd 50 numbers of seats will be increased this year stated by Prof. Agarwal. The meeting was ended with recapitulating the points raised by Principal and with formal vote of thanks proposed by Lt. Dr. Rasmirekha Sethy.

A Staff Council Meeting was held on 06th February, 2020, under the chairmanship of Principal Prof. P. C. Agarwal in the staff common room in the presence of twenty faculty members.

The Principal apprised the staff members and discussed about the following points.

- SCC Meeting for Odisha state was organized on 4th February, 2020. The SCC meetings for all the states are
 over except West Bengal. Principal requested the department to formulate the proposals and submit them for
 IAB meeting.
- Principal praised the Coordinators of Multicultural Placement Programme and Working with Community for successful completion of the Programmes. He also said that such programmes are appreciated by the students too.
- International conference "Education in 21st Century" will be held from 21st to 23rd February, 2020. Prof. Vasudha Kamath, Former V.C. SNDT Women's University Mumbai has given consent for key note address, Director, NCERT is also requested to be available during the conference. UNICEF is sponsoring 2/3 foreign delegates for the conference.
- Principal suggested that every year we should conduct an International Conference. DESM / DESSH may submit proposal for the year 2020-21.
- Director, NCERT has sent a letter praising the contribution made by the faculties of RIE, Bhubaneswar in NISTHA Programme.
- Chilika Research Study is going well and the reports are to be submitted.
- Principal suggested that there is no need to formulate Programme Proposal for Botanical Garden, as in the last
 year in PAC, the Institute was given responsibility to maintain it at Institute level. A gardener will be provided
 to maintain the Botanical Garden. A team of workers may be employed to make it usable. Prof. M. K.
 Satapathy expresses his concern that the Botanical Garden has become a wild land, it should be converted into
 a cultivated land and then only Botany Section will provide technical support.
- Prof. B. N. Panda discussed about Chilika Block Research Study. He suggested that one case study report should be submitted for each cluster of Chilika Block by 15th March, 2020. He also said that a proposal is to be submitted cluster wise of Chilika Block. Two volumes of Journal will be published initially w/o ISSN in the meantime application will be sent to get ISSN for the Journal and once it is received, it will be used even for those Journals which had already been published without ISSN.
- Dean of Instruction announced the date for 1st Internal Assessment and will be conducted from 12th to 14th February, 2020. It is proposed to conduct the Internal Assessment in future on the first three days of a week i.e. Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday instead of Wednesday, Thursday and Friday as students are reluctant to
