Chairperson welcomed all the members present in the meeting. Following points were discussed and suggested for consideration:-

- 1. Every Saturday a team of housekeeping staff under the supervision of any member of the Committee to collect and dispose the plastic waste littered in the Campus.
- 2. Coordinate with waste collecting BMC vehicle to gather the waste from the Institute, DMS. Hostels, Quarter areas on daily basis by which no waste materials should be either kept in any of the space in front and back side of the Institute and nor dumped in any of the dustbins.
- 3. Strigt instruction/Circular to be given not to use plastic bottles in any of the programme in the Campus. Plastic plates, cups etc. should be strictly banned in Institute campus.

4. C&W will fix strong and attractive hooks on the gates of all quarters to hang waste materials for NOTE collecting the same by BMC staff.

.Awareness banners (in bio degradable material) will be put up in key areas of the campus. SHEET Minimum ten banners may be prepared initially for the same.

- 6. One Saturday to be fixed to have a massive plastic collection drive involving NCC, NSS Volunteers, other students, House Keeping staff, all Staff members to collect the plastics in big disposable polythene bag to declare the campus polythene free. It is suggested that the 8th October 2022 may be fixed for the collection of plastic from the entire campus.
- 7. Sequrity Guards may be instructed to check and make aware everybody in the gates not to bring plastics from outside to the campus.





- The electronic wastes of the campus are collected by the BMC vehicles on Saturdays.
- Wood waste is used by the training teachers and students to develop various models which are displayed in the wood workshop of the Institute.
- Kitchen wastes (e.g. vegetable peels etc.) are used to maintain the kitchen garden of the hostels
- **Student Initiative**: The students initiated an innovative process to collect the plastics/polypacks in the plastic bottles to capture the macro-sized plastics to micro-sized plastics. This process will avoid spreading of plastics, choking of the drains by those plastics. These bottles can be further given to BMC or it can be creatively used for decorative purposes.

Additionally, the waste generated in the Institute is managed by Institute's Waste Management Policy






Fig. 18(a-f) -Kitchen Gardens from Kitchen Wastes Maintained by the Hostels in the Backyard and Frontyard of Different Hostels of RIE, Bhubaneswar.

8.3 LANDSCAPING AND GARDENING ACTIVITIES
